Introduction

The Uniform Application for Community Scholarships was created to help high school seniors be more efficient and effective with the use of their time. Utilizing this application will allow seniors to spend meaningful time writing essays for scholarships and providing other more specific information, in order to spotlight themselves as applicable for the individual scholarships. Seniors, and for any parents reviewing this application, it is an outstanding initiative on the part of the student to take the necessary steps to apply for any of these scholarships.

Hamilton Southeastern Education Foundation utilizes an online application platform called **SmarterSelect**. Before beginning the Uniform Application for Community Scholarships Application online process, please read the specific Scholarship Eligibility Requirements for each scholarship found in this booklet. Students also have the ability to *preview* scholarship applications through the SmarterSelect system.

Application Items

- 1. Uniform Application for Community Scholarships Form (complete Scholarship Application online using SmarterSelect.) <u>https://www.hsefoundation.org/scholarship-application</u>
- 2. Essay questions, financial information and/or special documents as listed in the Eligibility Requirements for each individual scholarship. Students may also need the contact information for their high school guidance office or guidance counselor.
- 3. In addition to basic contact information and future plans, students should be prepared to enter information regarding employment history, extra-curricular activities, and volunteerism. Some scholarships require letters of recommendation. Students may upload letters already in their possession or contact potential references via the SmarterSelect system.

Section A – Application Submittal Instructions

Each application should be submitted using the **SmarterSelect** program. <u>https://www.hsefoundation.org/scholarship-application/</u>

- 1. If a scholarship requires additional information, upload the required documentation to the electronic application.
- 2. If a scholarship requires recommendation letter(s), they must be submitted **PRIOR** to the application deadline. It is the applicant's responsibility to request letters of recommendation in advance and follow up on their status to ensure they are submitted before the deadline.
- 3. Required items not included with your application <u>may disqualify</u> you for the scholarship.
- 4. Please thoroughly read the essay questions before composing your essay.
- Double check your contents! It is the student's responsibility to submit the application and any additional documentation by the due date. The due dates may vary and are indicated both on the Available Scholarships List on the next page and in the Eligibility Requirements for each scholarship.
- 6. Most applications are due by 11:59pm on March 6, 2025. No exceptions will be made for late applications.

Abigail Cox Memorial Scholarship Due: 03/06/25

Hamilton Southeastern Education Foundation and the Abigail Cox Legacy Fund have established a memorial scholarship in honor of Abigail who died in a car accident July 5, 2023 while serving as a summer counselor at Kanakuk Christian Camp. Abigail, a 2021 graduate of Hamilton Southeastern High School, made the most of her high school career, participating in athletics, student council, National Honors Society and spirit club. She was also extremely passionate about serving in Young Life and other faith-based organizations ministering to area youth.

During her two years at Purdue, Abigail excelled in building connections with others and helping them grow through her sisterhood at Zeta Tau Alpha, Greek VI and Greater Lafayette Young Life. The foundation of Abigail's legacy is built on three pillars: live with intention, give more and love others deeply. The \$20,000, four-year scholarship (\$5,000 awarded annually) will be awarded to a student who meets the eligibility requirements and exemplifies Abigail's spirit. Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a senior at FHS or HHS
- Must have at least a 3.5 GPA as a senior, and maintain at least a 3.0 GPA in college in order to receive renewal awards
- Must attend Purdue University West-Lafayette for entirety of undergraduate program
- Must submit two letters of reference (one from a teacher/administrator and one from a non-relative)
- Must demonstrate academic achievement and held leadership roles
- Must have been involved in faith-based organizations, camps, or youth groups
- Must have displayed school spirit through participation in athletics or clubs/organizations
- Must submit an essay that expresses how their life experiences relate to Abigail's legacy

BSE Luke Butler Senior Scholarship Due: 03/06/25

In memory of Luke Butler, Brooks School Elementary will present a \$500 scholarship to a graduating senior from either HHS and/or FHS.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a senior at FHS or HHS
- Must have attended Brooks School Elementary for a minimum of one full school year
- Must submit a written explanation of post-high school plans
- Must submit a written explanation of how the scholarship will be used
- Must submit an essay on a life lesson learned while attending BSE that impacted the applicant's life
- Must have one letter of reference

Carrie Colglazier Memorial Scholarship Due: 03/06/25

Hamilton Southeastern High School, in cooperation with the Colglazier family, has established a memorial scholarship in honor of their daughter Carrie Colglazier who was tragically killed by a drunk driver on June 6th, 2003. Carrie was an HHS two sport, All State student- athlete in soccer and track. She was an active member of the FFA program and a member of National Honor Society. She was extremely passionate about her family, friends, teammates, teachers and coaches. Carrie took great pride in being a Royal! The \$16,000, four year scholarship (\$4,000 awarded annually) is funded by an endowment through the Hamilton Southeastern Education Foundation and by the Carrie Colglazier Community Service Workday.

The workday, which is held each fall (typically in September), includes workers from the Girls Soccer and Track teams, along with members of FFA and National Honor Society. Workers are asked to work up to an 8-hour day (8:00am-4:00pm) in the HSE schools community for a minimum \$25 donation per worker. All proceeds go toward the scholarship. - To be eligible, applicants must have participated in HHS Girls Soccer, HHS Girls Track, HHS National Honor Society, and/or FFA (either HHS or FHS).
- Applicants must have consistently participated in the Colglazier Community Service Workday in past years. (*There was not a formal work day in 2020.*)
- Applicants must have demonstrated academic achievement, leadership roles, and community service.
- Applicants must be a senior who plans to attend a two year or four-year college, university, vocational or trade school.
- Applicants must submit two letters of reference: one from teacher or administrator who can verify academic and leadership potential and one from a non-relative, community member. Letters of reference should speak specifically to the Carrie Colglazier Memorial Scholarship.
- Applicants are requested, but not required, to submit a current photo.
- Applicants should complete an essay entitled "Lessons Learned," describing a non-classroom experience during your four years at HHS /FHS that has impacted your personal growth. Describe the situation and the lessons that were learned through this experience.
- Applicants are strongly encouraged to include a resume in addition to the application that highlights extra-curricular activities, community service and leadership experiences.

Charles Leonard Scholarship Due: 03/06/25

A \$500 - \$1,500 scholarship will be awarded to a senior(s) at Hamilton Southeastern High School and/or Fishers High School.

- Must be a senior at HHS or FHS
- Must intend to major in a field related to education/teaching
- Must attend a four-year college or university
- Must have a minimum 3.0 GPA
- Must be involved in a variety of activities
- Must make a statement of your educational plans, career objectives and future goals

Chasity Bradford Memorial Scholarship Due: 03/06/25

A \$750 annual scholarship will be awarded in memory of Chasity Bradford to a senior member of the girl's track team from Hamilton Southeastern High School.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a senior at HHS
- Must be a member of the girl's track team
- Must have a 2.5 grade point average or higher
- Must demonstrate the qualities and characteristics of athletic achievement, kindness, friendliness, and community service
- Must have a letter of recommendation from a teacher, coach, or another advisor
- Make a statement of your future (education and career) goals

Chelsea M. Wheeler Memorial Scholarship Due: 03/06/25

In memory of 2009 FHS graduate Chelsea M. Wheeler, one \$500 scholarship is available to an FHS senior who expresses a strong interest in education, history, healthcare, or government.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a senior at FHS
- Must be entering a field of study in education, history, healthcare, or government
- Must submit two letters of reference
- Must complete an essay describing a life changing moment and how this will drive you to change someone else's life. (Max. 500 words)

Chris Condict Memorial Scholarship Due: 03/06/25

The Mudsock Football & Cheer Scholarship aims to recognize outstanding student-athletes who have demonstrated exceptional dedication both on and off the field. This \$1,000 scholarship is designed to support students who have been active participants in Mudsock Football or Cheer for at least two years (including Knights), meet certain academic requirements, and embody the core principles of Readiness, Respect, Effort, and Fun as exemplified by Coach Chris.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a senior at HHS or FHS
- Must have at least a 3.0 GPA
- Must have participated in Mudsock Youth Football or Cheer (including Knights) for at least 2 years
- Must submit one letter of reference from a coach detailing how the applicant has exhibited the four team principles of Chris Condict: Readiness, Respect, Effort, and Fun
- Must submit a resumé
- Must exhibit the four team principles of Chris Condict: Readiness, Respect, Effort, and Fun
- Must submit a personal statement highlighting your experiences in Mudsock Youth Football or Cheer, your academic achievements, and how you embody the principles of Readiness, Respect, Effort, and Fun. Must also include how your athletic career has impacted you beyond the field of play

<u>Clint Wilson Good Neighbor Spirit Scholarship</u> Due: 03/06/25

The Clint Wilson State Farm Good Neighbor Spirit Scholarship will award \$1,000 to two high school seniors from either HSE High School or Fishers High School who exemplify the "Good Neighbor" spirit.

- Must be a senior at FHS or HHS
- Must have at least a 3.0 GPA
- Must have plans for higher education (2-4 year university or trade school)
- Must submit two letter of reference
- Must submit a statement of future goals (further education and career)
- Must submit an essay sharing their definition of what it means to be a good neighbor and how they have demonstrated the good neighbor spirit by making a positive impact on their community

Dream Pursuit Scholarship Due: 03/06/25

Dream Pursuit Scholarship will award \$500 to two Fishers High School seniors who are planning to attend school after graduation and have been active members of the Future Black Leaders Club throughout their high school years.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a senior at FHS
- Must submit a resumé
- Must have plans for higher education (2-4 year university or trade school)
- Must submit one letter of reference from a teacher
- Must have actively participated in Future Black Leaders Club for a minimum of one year
- Must submit an essay on how you have promoted Black excellence at Fishers High School and how you plant to promote Black excellence at your chosen college/university
- Must submit an essay on how you have demonstrate the ability to lead, uplift, and mentor future Black leaders

Darrel J. Forsman Memorial Scholarship Due: 03/06/25

This \$1,500 scholarship honors the legacy of Darrel J. Forsman and will be awarded to a senior member of the basketball team (male or female) from HHS.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a senior at HHS
- Must be a member of the basketball team (male or female)
- Must have a minimum 3.0 GPA
- Must have demonstrated volunteer experiences either at school or in the community
- Must submit a brief summary of your college and career plans/goals
- Must include a summary of how basketball helped them achieve success on and off the court, both academically and athletically

Durbin/Deer Creek Elementary Alumni Scholarship Due: 03/06/25

This scholarship, in honor of Nettie Ann Schembra, is awarded through Deer Creek Elementary School to a former Durbin student(s) who is a graduate of HHS or FHS to help further his/her future endeavors, whether it be college, technical, or trade school. Award amount varies but is typically \$200.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a senior at HHS or FHS
- Must have attended Durbin Elementary School a minimum of two years (provide dates attended DES)
- Must submit a letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, or employer
- Must submit a brief summary of why you should be considered for a Durbin Elementary Scholarship. Include an explanation of how this scholarship will benefit you and the years and grades you attended Durbin. (Must be a minimum of 250 words and not exceed 500 words)

Fall Creek Elementary Alumni Senior Scholarship Due: 03/06/25

Sponsored by Fall Creek Elementary PTO, the FCE Alumni Senior Scholarship is a \$1,000 scholarship awarded to one student graduating from either HSEHS or FHS.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a senior at HHS or FHS
- Must have attended Fall Creek Elementary for at least one complete school year K-4
- Must have minimum 3.0 GPA
- Must write a statement of your educational goals, career objectives, and future plans.
- Must write a statement about what attending Fall Creek Elementary meant to you
- Must write a short essay on how this scholarship will impact you as you take the nest steps on your journey after high school

Fishers Dental Alliance Scholarship Due: 03/06/25

A \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to a senior at both Hamilton Southeastern High School and Fishers High School.

- Must be a senior at HHS or FHS
- Must major in a field related to dentistry (dentist, dental hygienist, etc.)
- Must attend a two or four-year college or university
- Must have a minimum 3.0 GPA
- Must be involved in a variety of activities
- Must make a statement of your plans as they relate to your educational and career objectives and future goals

Fishers Running Club Scholarship Due: 03/06/25

Fishers Running Club presents four \$1,000 scholarships to graduating seniors from either HSEHS and/or FHS.

- Must be a senior at HHS or FHS
- Must have GPA of 3.0 or above
- Have plans for higher education (trade school, 2 or 4 year college or university)
- Must have participated on your high school's cross country or track team
- Must submit two letters of reference, one from a coach and one from an unrelated adult
- Must write a short essay on who or what motivates you to run, and how running has impacted your life

Fishers High School Alumni Association Scholarship Due: 03/06/25

Four \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded (two to HHS seniors and two to FHS seniors) to students planning to attend a college, university or trade school. Preference will be given to students having a relative who attended the original Fishers High School or Hamilton Southeastern High School.

- Must be a senior at HHS or FHS
- Must have GPA of 3.0 or above
- Must write a short essay about yourself
- Must list any relative who attended and/or graduated from the original Fishers High School or Hamilton Southeastern High School

Fishers High School National Honor Society Scholarship Due: 03/06/25

Two \$500 scholarships will be awarded to two FHS NHS senior members in good standing.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a senior at FHS
- Must be a member in good standing of the FHS National Honor Society both semesters your senior year.
- Members on probation for attendance or service hours cannot apply.
- Must submit two letters of recommendation (exclusive of NHS Advisors)
- Must write a short essay explaining how you have exemplified the four pillars of National Honor Society.

Fishers Rotary Club Scholarship Due: 03/06/25

This \$1,000 scholarship is offered to six non-Rotarian children who are graduating seniors from FHS or HHS. Applicants are judged on citizenship, community service and the concept of "service above self".

- Must be a senior at FHS or HHS
- Must provide a letter from a current teacher that describes the student's citizenship, community service and overall qualities that they would like to be considered
- Must write a short response to three essay questions

Geist Elementary Memorial Scholarship Due: 03/06/25

Sponsored by Geist Elementary PTO, the Geist Elementary Memorial Scholarship awards two \$500 scholarships awarded to one male and one female student graduating from either Hamilton Southeastern High School or Fishers High School.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a senior at HHS or FHS
- Must have attended Geist Elementary for one complete school year K-4
- Must have a minimum 3.0 GPA
- Must be planning on attending a four-year college or university
- Be active in a variety of activities
- Must make a statement of your educational plans, career objectives and future goals
- Must write a 300-500 word essay on what attending GES meant to you in your education

HBCU Fair Scholarship Due: 03/06/25

Leadership from Carmel Schools, Hamilton Southeastern Schools and Noblesville Schools will present an award to a graduating senior (1 from each school) that attended the HBCU Fair on September 5th, 2024. Noblesville Schools hosts the application for this scholarship here: https://smr.to/p83434

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a senior at HHS or FHS
- Must have a minimum 2.5 GPA
- Must have attended the HBCU Fair on 9/5/24 (will confirm attendance)
- Must attach an autobiography of no more than two pages
- Must attach 1 letter of recommendation

HRE Kristal Sergi Memorial Scholarship Due: 03/06/25

Sponsored by HRE Faculty, the HRE Kristal Sergi Memorial Scholarship is a \$500 scholarship awarded to one student graduating from either Hamilton Southeastern High School or Fishers High School.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a senior at HHS or FHS
- Must have attended Hoosier Road Elementary for one complete school year K-4
- Must submit one letter of reference
- Must make a statement of your educational plans, career objectives and future goals
- Must submit an essay on interests, passions and a life lesson learned during your educational experience

HIJH Alumni Scholarship Due: 03/06/25

HIJH presents \$500 - \$1,000 scholarship(s) to HHS or FHS senior students who attended HIJH for four years.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a senior at HHS or FHS
- Must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75
- Must have attended HIJH for four years (grades 5-8)
- Must submit a resume
- Must submit plans for post-high school (including college, trade school, or military)
- Must submit an essay on how your connection to or time spent at Hamilton Southeastern Intermediate and Junior High impacted who you have become (your character), and/or the plans that you have for the future

HSE Best Buddies Scholarship Due: 03/06/25

One \$2,500 scholarship will be awarded to a Hamilton Southeastern High School senior in memory of Jake Willmann.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a senior at HHS
- Must be a member of HSE High School Best Buddies
- Must be accepted to a higher education program

HSE Peer Tutoring Scholarship Due: 03/06/25

A \$1,000 scholarship will be available to seniors from HSE High School who have been involved in the Adult Transition peer tutoring program.

- Must be a senior at HHS
- Must have been a member of the HSE Adult Transitions Peer Tutoring program for 2 years (4 semesters) or more
- Must have plans for higher education (trade school, two-year and four-year degrees)
- Must submit essay explaining how peer tutoring has benefited you in high school

HSEA Aspiring Educators Scholarship Due: 03/06/25

Two \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to seniors who intend to become teachers. School involvement, community service, character, work ethic and deservedness considered. One scholarship is allocated to each high school.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a senior at HHS or FHS
- Must be pursing a career as a teacher
- Must submit one letter of recommendation
- Must submit one essay from a choice of two essay prompts:
 - Explain the three qualities/skills every teacher must possess to be effective.
 - Describe a person with a passion for teaching. What are his/her classroom behaviors and practices? Describe the students in his/her classroom. How does the teacher develop and/or maintain this passion for teaching?

HSE Fishers Academy Scholarship Due: 03/06/25

Hamilton Southeastern Fishers Academy will present a \$200 scholarship to qualifying graduating seniors from one of the three HSE Fishers Academy locations.

- Must have completed 5 credits at the Academy
- Must meet high school graduation requirements
- Must be enrolled in post-secondary academic or training program
- Must complete essay describing what the Academy has meant to the applicant

HSEF Legacy Scholarship Due: 03/06/25

Hamilton Southeastern Education Foundation will present a \$2,000 scholarship to a senior at both Hamilton Southeastern High School and Fishers High School who exemplifies the principles of the Hamilton Southeastern Education Foundation. The HSEF Legacy Scholarship will recognize students who **connect** with others, **invest** their time in their fellow students or school in an innovative way to **advance** experiences for current and future students and staff of Hamilton Southeastern Schools.

- Must be a senior at HHS or FHS
- Must have attended HSE Schools for a minimum of eight years
- Must exemplify the HSEF principles: connect, invest, advance
- Must enroll in continuing education next year (2 or 4 year college/university, or trade school)
- Must have a minimum of one year of service to any local area non-profit
- Must submit an essay:
 - demonstrating how you connected to and invested in your community in an innovative way during your time with HSE Schools
 - stating how your experience with HSE Schools (both inside and outside the classroom) has prepared you to be an innovative leader in the future
 - explaining how your experiences at HSE Schools advance experiences for future and current students

Ivy Tech Hamilton County Scholarship Due: 03/06/25

This \$2,500 scholarship will be awarded to a current senior from either Fishers High School Hamilton Southeastern High School who plans on attending a Hamilton County Ivy Tech campus in 2025-26. Please note, it is exclusively for incoming Ivy Tech students attending the Hamilton County campus and is not available for students enrolled at other Ivy Tech locations or for those in dual enrollment programs.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a senior at FHS or HHS
- Must attend a Hamilton County Ivy Tech campus in 2025-26
- Must submit a personal statement of future plans
- Must submit a statement about how this scholarship will help you achieve your career goals

Jason Sipher Memorial Scholarship Due: 03/06/25

This \$1,500 scholarship was established in honor of Jason Sipher, a 2011 graduate of Fishers High School. Jason was a dedicated athlete in wrestling, cross-country and track, lettering numerous times. He was awarded the "Heart of the Tiger" award in his senior season of cross-country. Jason also served on the Student Athletic Council and returned several times post-graduation to assist in wresting or running clubs or events. - Must submit an essay about how you have been affected by personal or family struggles with mental health

Thomas E. Reece Scholarship Due: 03/06/25
